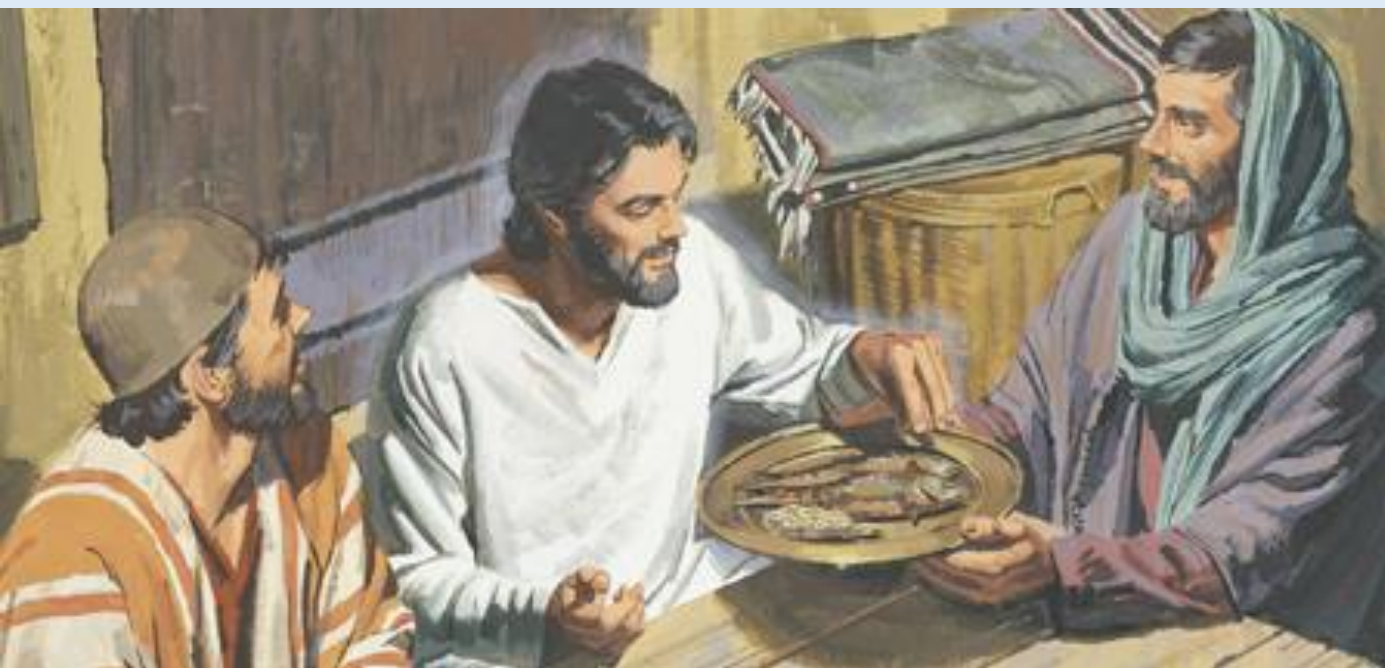


THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER YEAR B

GOSPEL – Luke 24:36b-48



Luke 24:36b-48

Abòḡnə Yesu Kristò ma Lukasè Nwà'anè â ḡwà'arê.

Mèkwu'utənè dzwi a mbwo wwò o Nfò wii.

Ma bwo kə brə mboḡnə la, Yesù yìi ntiḡə atətě bwo, nswiḡə a mbwo bwo ḡə, “Mbõnè dzwi nnu bùu.”

Bwo wìkə nti'i mbo susu, nti'i nwi'itə ḡə bwo zə bə ñkwu.

Yesù biḡsè wwa ḡə, “Bùu bo li kə susu, nkə nghanə li kə mətiḡə buù lə?

Lìnənè mbwo ma bwo məkù mâ nzənè ḡə à tèsə mbə tse'è mwò. Nja nè wa nzə; nkwi bikàkê nə ñnà nnu bwo bə èkwě nnu zhə dzwi ma mə dzwi nè dzwu lĩ.

Ma â swiḡə li la nti'i ndəsə mbwo myi bwo məkù myi a mbwo bwo. Ma bwo kə yè'èsə la mbrə nghanə, kakə məntiḡə bwo mbiḡə la, Yesù swiḡə ḡə, “Bù dzwi nè àzuḡə dàḡə fĩ mə jyənè?”

Bwo fya àkəmè nəbye zə lǎnə a mbwo zhə. A kwε nkhwurə nshi bwo.

A ti'i nswiḡə a mbwo bwo ḡə, “Li abòḡnə za ma mē fya nè bù a fè'è wu ma binə brə ndzwi la – ḡə ànyù ntsəmè zu ma bə ḡwà'arə məmə ntəə Mose nə zə bə bròfetà nə àḡwà'arə samsə bə bə nkò'onyù.

A ti'i nyε'ε tyə zha bwo zhi anyù zu ma Àḡwà'arə Nwà'anè swiḡə.

A ti'i nswiḡə a mbwo bwo ḡə, “Bə ḡwà'arə ḡə Ñkwesə (Mezayà) à dzwi nè mètənə ḡə'ə lyə ti'i bəḡnə nəwwo nə njwe tarə,

ḡə bē bə kə nswiḡə anyù kwèbərə məntiḡə nə mənà'anè mə əbwu nə əlwenə yi fə adi'ĩ ntsəmè, zhìtə fəfə Yerəsalemə.

Bù zə mənnyu mi mətsəmè ma mə chya lĩ.

Àbòḡnə Yesu Kristò.

Luke 24:36b-48

24:36b While they were talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, “Peace be with you.”

24:37 They were startled and terrified, and thought that they were seeing a ghost.

24:38 He said to them, “Why are you frightened, and why do doubts arise in your hearts?”

24:39 Look at my hands and my feet; see that it is I myself. Touch me and see; for a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have.”

24:40 And when he had said this, he showed them his hands and his feet.

24:41 While in their joy they were disbelieving and still wondering, he said to them, “Have you anything here to eat?”

24:42 They gave him a piece of broiled fish,

24:43 and he took it and ate in their presence.

24:44 Then he said to them, “These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you—that everything written about me in the law of Moses, the prophets, and the psalms must be fulfilled.”

24:45 Then he opened their minds to understand the scriptures,

24:46 and he said to them, “Thus it is written, that the Messiah is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day,

24:47 and that repentance and forgiveness of sins is to be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem.

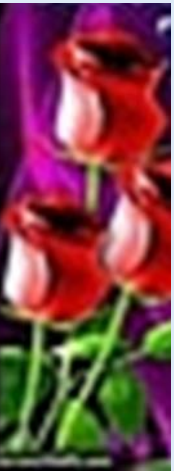
24:48 You are witnesses of these things.
